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

Highlighting the fact that the total groundwater used for irrigation has risen from 30% in the 1980s to nearly 60% today.



Enhancing Cyber Security Skills: E & ICT IIT-Kanpur 5th - 9th June, 2023




Expert Talk on Al in Cybersecurity 19th June, 2023
