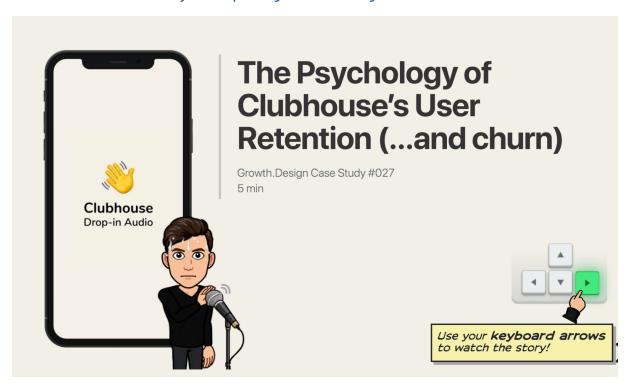

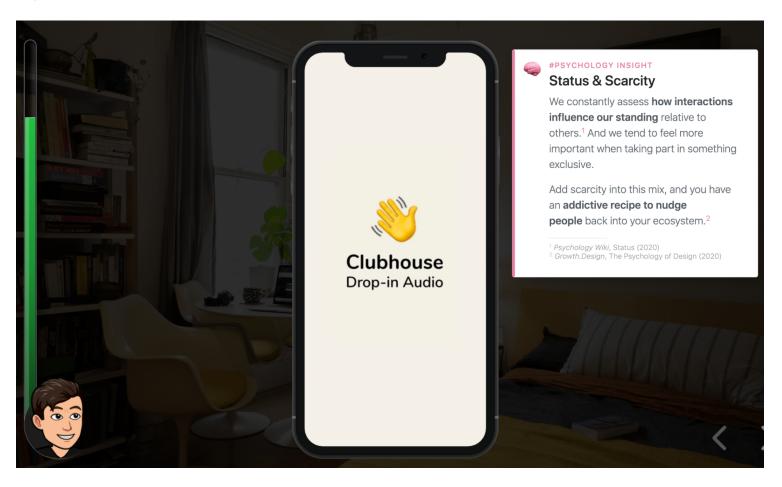
## CHECKLIST - 5 Principles To Increase User Retention

- ① TALK TO CUSTOMERS: Understanding your customers' deepest desires, pains, and barriers will help you define their jobs-to-be-done. You can also directly ask: Why did you hire our product? What were you trying to solve? This will also help you align your long-term key business metric with your customers' benefits.
- © CONSCIOUS ONBOARDING: Even if you have key metrics you'd like to reach during the onboarding, remember that users need to get value first. Try to create an onboarding that will be the beginning of a long-term relationship. Focus on 1 thing.
- ③ W LIFECYCLE EMAILS: Prepare a plan to inform new users over a longer period of the key features in your product they might find helpful. (you can adjust & personalize based on usage too!)
- ④ **SEGMENT NOTIFICATIONS:** Not everyone will want to receive the same message at the same time. Make sure you segment your users by either usage or goals.
- (5) AVOID THE "FEATURE CREEP" PARADOX: It's tempting to keep adding features that customers are requesting. But be careful not to fall too quickly into the trap of just transferring overall complexity to users. Even if they ask for it, they'll soon churn for something simpler. (see The Messy Middle)

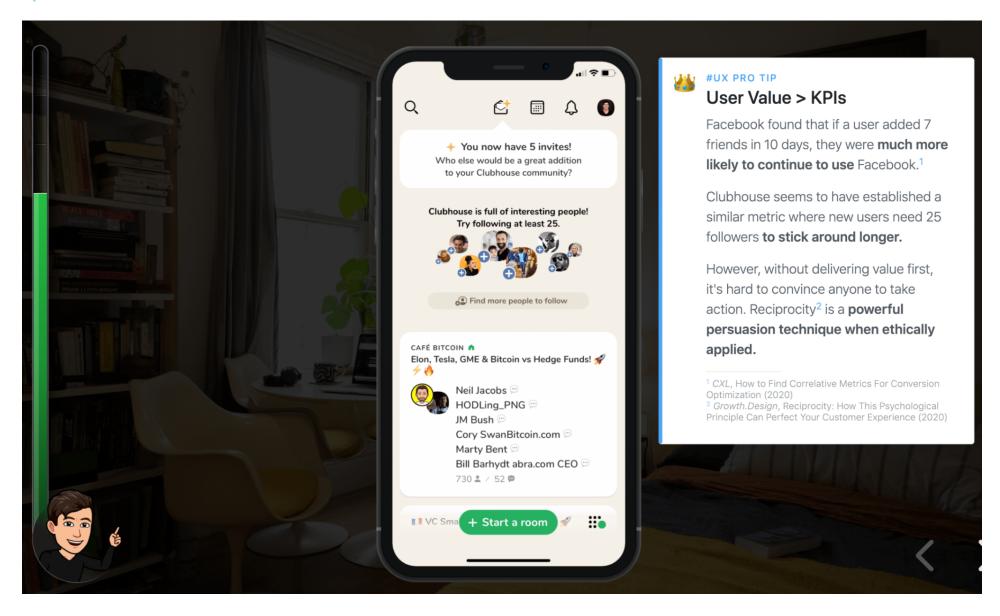

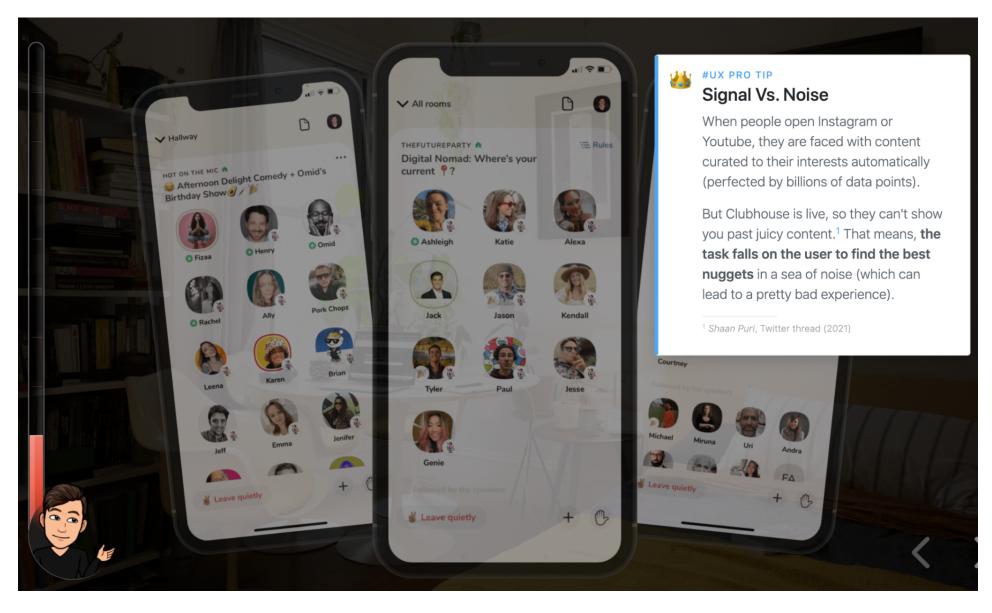
