This summit aims to drive actions that deepen catalytic capital in West Africa, creating an enabling environment for impactful investments that drive positive social and environmental change. The primary objective is to galvanise stakeholders, foster collaborative efforts, and mobilise action to accelerate the deployment of catalytic capital in the region.

#### **SUMMIT OVERVIEW**

The 2024 West Africa Deal Summit will be a two-day event, featuring various components such as panel discussions, expert presentations, fireside chats, interactive workshops, masterclasses, deal rooms, an impact fund showcase, exhibitions, policy dialogues, and recommendations. It will kick off with the 7th Annual Convening on Impact Investing, organised by the Impact Investors Foundation (IIF), aimed at addressing barriers to the growth of the impact investment ecosystem in Nigeria through a multi-stakeholder platform process. This convening is the largest gathering of impact investment stakeholders in Nigeria.

It will then be followed by the 2024 West Africa Deal Summit, which is the region's premier meeting place to start and close conversations that actually move funding to where it can have the biggest impact and provide a good return. This event brings together investors, innovative financing vehicles, businesses and policymakers who want to be part of building a vibrant local ecosystem and effective partnerships with the global ecosystem.

#### **SUMMIT FOCUS AREAS**

#### The summit will focus on four key areas:

- Tracking and Reporting Impact and Impact Investing Commitments: Building on the momentum generated during the 2023 West Africa Deal Summit (WADS) in Accra, Ghana, the 2024 summit will track and report on the impact investing ecosystem stakeholder commitments made in the Joint Statement and Call to Action. This will provide a transparent assessment of progress and analyse successes and challenges faced by stakeholders in mobilising and deploying catalytic capital since the previous summit.
- Deepening Gains from the 2CAfrica Campaign: The summit will provide an opportunity to deepen the gains achieved since the launch of the 3year Catalytic Capital to Transform Africa (2CAfrica) campaign at the 2023 WADS. Participants will explore success stories, challenges, and lessons learned, assess the impact of initiatives undertaken under the campaign, and strategize on how to further leverage catalytic capital for sustainable development.
- Promoting Locally-Led Initiatives: The summit will showcase innovative projects and enterprises that have successfully leveraged catalytic capital to drive sustainable development and social impact within the region. It emphasises supporting locally-led initiatives and home-grown solutions.
- Creating an Enabling Environment: Discussions will centre on creating an enabling policy and regulatory environment that encourages and supports catalytic capital investments. Best practices, lessons from other regions, and strategies for overcoming barriers to impactful investments will be addressed.

#### **EXPECTED OUTCOMES**

Major outcomes expected from the 2024 WADS include:

**1.** Mobilise \$100 million in new catalytic capital commitments: Attracting \$100 million in new commitments from impact investors, development finance institutions, philanthropic organisations, and private sector players during the summit.

**2. Establish impactful policy recommendations for catalytic capital investments:** Creating concrete policy recommendations that promote and support catalytic capital investments in West Africa.

**3. Enhance impact measurement practices of 30 participating organisations:** Improving the impact measurement practices of 30 participating organisations, including government MDAs, impact investors, enterprises, and NGOs.

**4.** Facilitate impactful linkages for a minimum of 20 impact enterprises with at least 10 impact investors and strengthen existing platforms for deal sourcing, matchmaking, and successful deal closures, and thus unlock the potential for social enterprises and impact-driven businesses.

**5. Foster cross-sector collaborations through strategic partnerships:** Establishing 10 strategic partnerships between impact investors, enterprises, NGOs, and government representatives to drive collaborative solutions over a period of one year - between the 2024 and 2025 WADS.
