## 1.Function description ofCCT \& Wattage Tunable:

1.If the luminaire is designed to be wattage tunable. Please unscrew the knob cap before using the watt selectable function. According to the watt selectable label shown in Fig. 5, please toggle the DIP switch to select the corresponding watt. Screw the knob cap after using the watt selectable function.
2.If the lamp is designed to be tunable by CCT. Before using the CCT optional function, please remove the lid. According to the CCT optional label shown in Figure 5, please switch the DIP switch to select the corresponding color temperature. After using the optional function of CCT, use tools to tighten the lid.
