2. Examine the methods used by Samori Toure in creating and preserving his empire.
3. To what extent did the conditions in Africa promote its colonisation by European powers in the late nineteenth century?
4. Analyse the causes of the Maji Maji Uprising of 1905 – 1907.

Section B

5. 'Louis XVI's character flaws were the main cause of the 1789 crisis in France.' How far do you agree with this assertion?
6. How far did the Civil Constitution of the Clergy (1790) divide French Society during the Revolution?
7. 'The rise of Napoleon Bonaparte to power in 1799 can be attributed to the weaknesses of the Directory.' Discuss.
8. To what extent can Napoleon 1's foreign policy up to 1814 be described as a 'resounding success'?

Section C

9. To what extent can it be argued that the Vienna statesmen in 1815 focused on international stability at the expense of the wishes and aspirations of the people?
10. Evaluate the view that the great powers in Europe regarded the Congress system as a tool to suppress nationalist movements up to 1825.
11. 'Despite the weaknesses of his reign, Louis XVIII's rule left remarkable results.' Discuss.
12. Examine the role played by Prussia in German unification up to 1871.

- 14 Discuss the view that 'without the United States of America (USA), the League of Nations was doomed to fail.'
